

# CLASS OF 2023 UNIVERSITY DESTINATIONS



#### **OUR SCHOOL**

Dulwich International High School Suzhou (DHSZ) is an independent co-educational high school for students aged 14-19. Having opened our doors in 2012, we currently have 750 student on the roll of which 155 are in the Class of 2024. Chinese students make up the great majority of the student body. In line with the educational philosophy of Dulwich College, our founding school in London, the high school offers a challenging academic and holistic educational approach to its students. This is centred on an enhanced international curriculum leading to externally assessed International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) examinations at the end of Year 11 (Grade 10). The students progress to the UK's Advanced Level (A-Level) qualification, awarded by Cambridge Assessment International Education (CAIE) & Edexcel. The school delivers an extensive co-curriculum incorporating sports, music and performing arts that allows students to develop their creativity along with teamwork and leadership skills. The language of instruction is English, and every student benefits from a structured cultural programme preparing them for life at universities abroad.

#### SCHOOL CALENDAR

The class of 2024 experienced perpetual difficulties in the Academic Year 2021-22 when their external exams were cancelled and the exam boards used Portfolio of Evidence (POE) to decide the grades. Some students re-took the IGCSE and some focused instead on AS levels. Grades are listed on the transcripts as normal. Thankfully, exams were back to normal in 2023 and certificates will be available with the Mid-term transcripts as normal. A-Level and AS grades were returned to the pre-COVID levels by the UK Education Bureau in 2023, meaning that many students will have lower than expected grades.

### **ACADEMIC PROGRAMMES**

IGCSE – Years 10 and 11 (Grades 9 and 10)

Students participate in a compulsory common core consisting of mathematics, English and a choice of sciences: physics/chemistry/biology. They choose an additional two subjects at the IGCSE level. Students participating in the one-year accelerated IGCSE program take five compulsory subjects.

#### A-Level - Years 12 and 13 (Grades 11 and 12)

Most students study four AS courses in Year 12, taking three of these through to A-Level in Year 13. In addition, all students study an internally assessed English course, incorporating academic English, critical thinking and discussion skills. This is designed to ensure that students are well prepared to integrate and participate at university.

Marquette University x DHSZ From 2023 our students have been taking Liberal Arts, English and Art courses with US Course Credits externally awarded by Marquette University Explorer Program. These courses aim to prepare our students for life at universities worldwide, and focus on critical thinking skills, content knowledge and general transferable skills.

#### **OUR STUDENT BODY**

The majority of our students are Chinese nationals who must pursue university studies outside of China. Our students opt out of the Chinese education system at the end of middle school.

All students go on to study at high-ranking universities worldwide.


