### **OVERVIEW**:

The program will begin with our patented "Carnival of Capitalism:" student groups will complete team-building challenges to earn tokens that can be exchanged for materials needed for a culminating engineering challenge. Day 2 will be spent at Lion's Head Cliff, engaging in rock climbing and abseiling on an outdoor cliff. On day 3, students will visit Baoshoushan Scenic Area for "Beach Olympics" and a kayaking activity. The program will conclude with a beautiful bike ride along Qingshan Lake's greenway bike path. Our team of professional instructors will keep students engaged through activity facilitation, interactive games, and reflections.

# **PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS**



The raft-building challenge is invariably one of the highlights. In small groups, students will be challenged to build functional rafts with only bamboo, water drums or inner tubes, and short pieces of rope. The activity will include instruction in knot-tying and basic raft design, after which point students will be set loose and encouraged to use creativity. The activity will end with a race, and some time to splash about in the water.





The program will include a day at Baoshoushan (宝寿山风景区), an artificial white sand beach and lake. Here, there will be a kayaking session and "Beach Olympics activity;" KA guides will facilitate a team-based multi-activity competition on the beach, including sand castle building, relay races, and more.

A focal point of this program will be a service learning project in Longshang Village, Lin'an, Hangzhou. The campsite and natural rock climbing areas require continuous upkeep, especially in controlling overgrowth and erosion. Towards this end, students on this program will work to improve the campsite and access to the rock climbing area. This might involve the clearing of brush, building bamboo fences and benches, and work to mitigate erosion on the rock climbing access trail.

Most of the activities on this program will take place in Lin'an District, west of Hangzhou city. The centerpiece of Lin'an is the magnificent Qingshan Lake. Here, students will have the chance to do a 15-20KM bike loop along a designated "greenway" bike path. The route is in a beautiful natural environment, and circumnavigates part of the lake, complete with viaducts and even bike-only bridges.
