Collecting Pupils

A late school bus will be available on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday at 4:40 pm. Pupils can take the late bus home from College after CCAs, or parents can collect their children after CCAs. On Monday and Friday, there will be no late school bus, and pupils must be collected by parents from College at the end of the CCA. While most CCAs end at 4:30 pm, some may end later. If your child is in a CCA that ends after 4:30 pm, they must either leave the CCA early to take the late bus or be picked up from school.

If a CCA is canceled due to unforeseen circumstances, we will arrange a refund or make-up class. The CCA department will inform parents of the details if such an arrangement is needed. Please note that refunds or make-up classes will not be arranged for students who withdraw partway through the term or miss a lesson due to personal issues.



In Term 3, Mustangs will take part in several online fixtures with international schools across Asia. With a bespoke esports curriculum linked directly to the IB Learner Profile and that develops both physical and mental resilience in team members, the Mustangs esports ensures that students aren't just playing video games after school, but becoming young people who Live Worldwise in how they approach any challenge. Not only limited to the competitive games themselves, students will also learn about the wider esports world –something which is undergoing rapid change in China, and in Shanghai specifically. For Term 3, esports will be open to select Year 6 students as part of their transition into Senior school, with trials to take place at the beginning of term.





LAMDA is an accredited awarding body of Ofqual(The Office of the Qualifications and Examinations Regulator in England). Communication and Performance Examinations at Level 3 are recognised within the UCAS tariff for UK University entrance, thus proving popular with many senior students.

Please note that CCA allocations are not based on a first-come, first-served basis. The timing of your registration (whether on Monday, March 18, or Friday, March 23) will not affect your allocation. We encourage you to take your time and select preferences 1, 2, and 3 that your child is happy to participate in.

How can I ensure that I don't miss the sign-up deadline for CCAs?

To ensure you don't miss the sign-up deadline for CCAs, please make a note of the sign-up window on Schools Buddy. The deadline for Term 3 is March 22, 2024.

What should I do if I miss the sign-up for CCAs?

If you miss the sign-up for CCAs, please email the CCA team at CCAshanghaipuxi@dulwich.org. Please note that there will be limited availability, and we strongly encourage all parents to submit their requests before 5 pm on March 22.

What should I do if I want to change the CCAs allocated?

We value your feedback and have updated our process. If you wish to change the CCAs allocated, please email the CCA team at CCAshanghaipuxi@ dulwich.org. You will receive a QR code to update your requests. Please be aware that we can only accommodate a limited number of requests based on availability and current CCA allocations for your child.
