In addition to receiving a reduction in tuition fees, successful candidates will be formally recognised as a Dulwich Scholar, enhancing their academic portfolio when applying for universities.

Benefits

Students awarded a Creative Arts Scholarship will receive the following benefits:

- A reduction in tuition fees to an amount determined at the sole discretion of the Head of College.
- Be formally recognised as a Dulwich Scholar, receiving a certificate of award at the successful completion of each academic year, where the scholar has demonstrated successful evidence of fulfilling the Scholarship Expectations.
- Be invited to engage in a range of opportunities, experiences and responsibilities that will both deepen their experience in their scholarship field and allow them to build a strong resume of achievements.

Desired Aptitudes and Traits

For the Sports Scholarship, The College is seeking candidates who are high level athletes with the strong desire to compete and immerse themselves into the sporting culture of The College and our Mustangs teams. We want to see candidates with a strong desire to achieve, pride and belief in sporting prowess, and above all outstanding sportsmanship and passion for development in sport.

Scholarship Selection Criteria

Upon application, candidates should submit the following supporting documentation and evidence:

- A 500-1000-word personal statement by the student expressing the contribution they intend to make at The College and beyond.
- Evidence to demonstrate that they are competing or training regularly showing excellence in their chosen sport.
- Evidence that the candidate has competed at the equivalent of a city, province/state or national level of competition, including any grades or achievements associated with competition. Video evidence would be accepted in lieu of certificates of achievement.

The Audition/Trial

Shortlisted candidates will be invited to attend a Scholarship Interview and Assessment Day where they will:

- Attend an interview with the Head of College, Head of Senior School, Director of Sport and other academic leaders.
- Participate in a demonstration of their chosen first and secondary sport/activity in a staged and competitive setting.
- Complete a basic fitness tests relative to their sport/activity.
- Complete a short written test.

Scholarship Expectations

Scholarships are awarded for two years. Those receiving the scholarship for Years 10 and 11 are eligible to continue receiving the award for an additional two years (Years 12 and 13), however renewal is determined upon an annual review of the scholar's academic and extra-curricular performance by a review panel.

Throughout their time at The College, Sports Scholars are expected to fulfill the following requirements:

- **Mustang Participation:** Compete with the Mustang teams to represent the school at local and international events.
- **Training:** Commit to training with school teams whilst maintaining any outside of school training. This may include Saturday training and after school Co-Curricular Activities.
- **Sporting Initiative:** It is a requirement for those awarded the scholarship in Year 10 to take IGCSE sport.
- **Leadership:** Demonstrate evidence of ongoing leadership in the area of sports throughout The College.
- **Academic Success:** All Dulwich Scholars are expected to maintain their academic progress, successfully completing their IGCSEs and IB Diploma Programme commitments, alongside their scholarship duties.
- **Behaviour and Values:** Dulwich Scholars should act in good faith at all times and uphold exemplary standards of behaviour and character. They should demonstrate the Dulwich College Shanghai Puxi school values, and act as a role model for other students.

Final decisions on the awarding and renewal of all scholarships are at the sole discretion of the Head of College.
