

PARENT INFORMATION FOR ONLINE LEARNING



BALANCE

A balance of learning tasks will be set for students, which includes both online and offline activities. Students will be given time to complete tasks away from electronic devices.



TEACHER PROVISION

Teachers will be available during all timetabled sessions to support students, should they need help.



TIMETABLES

Students will be provided with a full timetable to follow, with teachers available during every session.



VARIETY

Students will have registration, lessons and assemblies to give variety to the provision they are experiencing. The same rewards used in school will be applied in the online environment



REPETITION

Students need to ensure they have their full English name when using Microsoft TEAMS, have their cameras on, and mute their microphones when not speaking. This repetition helps to ensure lessons run smoothly and children are identified clearly.



PATTERN

Attendance and engagement will be closely monitored with families being contacted to ensure students are supported successfully.



RHYTHM

Once students settle into the rhythm of online learning house events and extra-curricula activities will be introduced to provide provision outside of the academic curriculum.



UNITY

Students, parent representatives, and all parents will be communicated and consulted with to ensure provision adapts and improves throughout the online journey.
