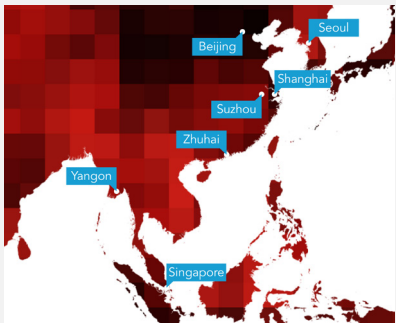

DCSPD is one of ten (8 IBDP; 2 A Level) international schools in Asia that operate in partnership with the 400-year-old founding school in London, under the World Charter. Together, these schools make up Dulwich College International (DCI). Dulwich College in London inspects DCSPD and each Dulwich international school annually.

OUR SCHOOL

Founded in 2003, Dulwich College Shanghai Pudong (DCSPD) is an independent international school serving expatriate 1606 English-speaking students, 253 students are in Years 10-13 (Grades 9-12). There are 47 students in the Class of 2021.

Our students come from over 40 countries and range in age from 2 to 19. Up to Year 9 (Grade 8) they follow the English National Curriculum, enhanced to meet the needs of our international student body. All students follow an accredited High School Diploma programme. More specifically, in Years 10 and 11 (Grades 9 and 10) they follow the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) curriculum, a two-year course culminating in externally assessed examinations. In Years 12 and 13 (Grades 11 and 12) all our students enter the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme.

English is the language of instruction.

SCHOOL CALENDAR COVID-19 UPDATE

The school year is 180 days, running from September to mid-June.

Dulwich College Shanghai Pudong experienced COVID-19 like most schools in Shanghai: students left campus for the Chinese New Year at the end of January and were not able to return to campus until the end of the school year. From February through May, the entire student body participated in online classes, and because of our diverse population, many continued distance learning from all over the world even after we resumed in-person classes. At present, every member of the class of 2021 is on-campus, participating in a traditional classroom setting. Due to COVID 19, many of our students were unable to sit for standardized tests like the SAT and ACT. Because there is such a small sample size, we are not publishing our median scores for this school year.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Students are offered a rich co-curricular programme that builds on team and leadership skills. Many of our programmes are student-initiated and led. Across the College, there are dance, drama, creative arts, music, sports, robotics, academic societies, language and service groups. Service is a hallmark of Dulwich College Shanghai Pudong, and students are actively involved in the local area as well as globally.

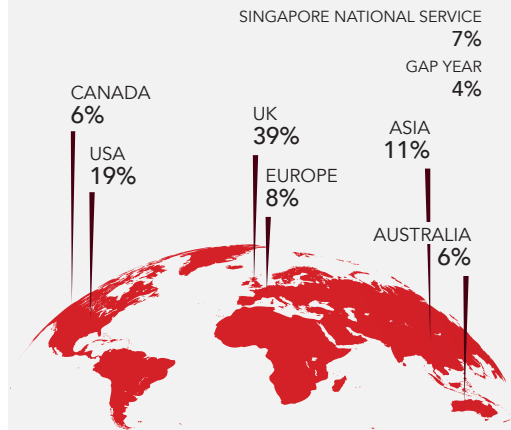
GRADING

Upon request, DCSPD will report all external suspensions and withdrawals that arise as a result of a significant disciplinary incident or personal misconduct.

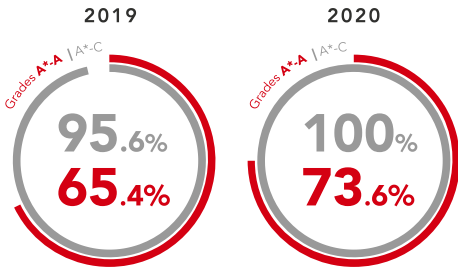
CLASS OF 2020 UNIVERSITY DESTINATIONS
