Dulwich College Suzhou (DCSZ) is one of eight international schools in Asia that operate in partnership with Dulwich College, our founding school in London, under the World Charter and together they make up Dulwich College International (DCI). Dulwich College inspects DCSZ and each Dulwich international school annually.

OUR SCHOOL

Dulwich College Suzhou (DCSZ) is a British independent international school serving 962 expatriate English-speaking students, of whom 43 are in the Class of 2021. Our students come from over 40 countries and range in age from 2 to 18. Up to Year 9 (Grade 8), they follow the English National Curriculum, enhanced to meet the needs of our international student body. In Years 10 and 11 (Grades 9 and 10) they follow the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE), a two-year course culminating in externally assessed examinations. In Years 12 and 13 (Grades 11 and 12) all our students enter the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP). Based on individual needs and plans, some students will complete IB subject certificates and/or internally assessed exams to earn a High School Diploma (HSDP).

SCHOOL CALENDAR COVID-19 UPDATE

The school year is 181 days, running from mid-August to mid-June. It is divided into three terms. Due to Covid-19, the Class of 2022 started the academic year in a virtual learning environment. Previously, DCSZ has held in-person instruction, outside of a two month period from February 2020 to April 2020. The Class of 2021 completed their externally assessed final IB Exams, and we trust the Class of 2022 will have the same opportunity. Instances in which students were adversely affected by changes to their learning, including lack of access to standardized testing or major disruptions to testing plans, will be directly addressed in the application.

ACADEMIC PROGRAMMES

IGCSE - Years 10 and 11 (Grades 9 and 10)

Students take up to 11 individual examination subjects in the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) course. Many of our students also study an accelerated mathematics programme. All students may choose Double or Triple Award Science at IGCSE. While both options include physics, chemistry and biology, Triple Award Science is more rigorous. Grades are on a scale of A* to G for Cambridge subjects and 9 to 1 for Edexcel subjects, with a letter grade of U indicating a failure to meet minimum standards.

IB Diploma Programme - Years 12 and 13 (Grades 11 and 12)

All DCSZ students start the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP) in Year 12 (Grade 11) in preparation for university.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

At DCSZ, the Co-Curricular Activity (CCA) programme covers many of the activities that take place beyond the taught curriculum. We consider this to be an integral part of the students' journey through their schooling, as it affords an opportunity for students to experience and deepen their interests and abilities in a wide range of areas. Our CCA programme offers numerous activities in the areas of Academia, The Arts, and Sport. Last year, the College introduced an Enrichment focus to the programme, consisting of a range of Societies that reflect students' key learning areas including a Science Society, a Mathematics Society, a Law Society, and an Entrepreneurial Society.

GRADING

We do not rank our students or calculate grade point averages. For the duration of course work, student progress is continuously assessed. DCSZ reports triannually using pre-established, standards-based performance levels. Years 10 and 12 conclude with internally assessed exams while Years 11 and 13 conclude with externally assessed examinations.

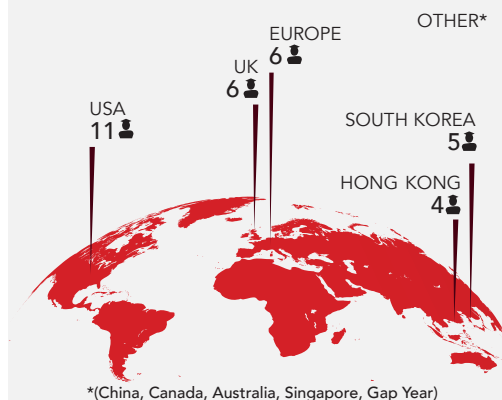
DISCIPLINE POLICY

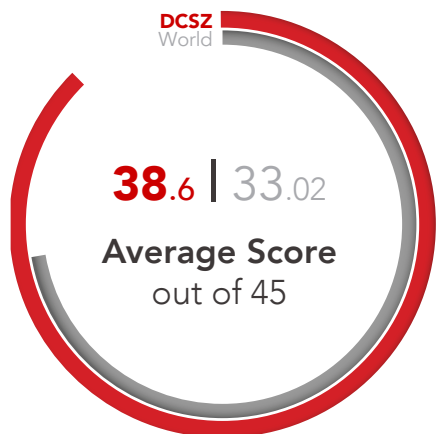
CLASS OF 2021 UNIVERSITY DESTINATIONS

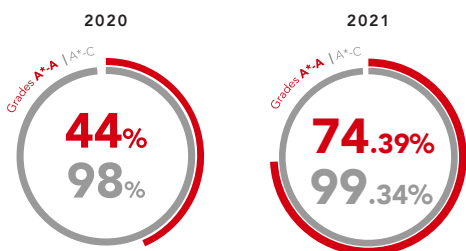
