OUR SCHOOL

Dulwich College Suzhou (DCSZ) is a British independent international school serving 765 expatriate Englishspeaking students, of whom 37 are in the Class of 2024. Our students come from over 40 countries and range in age from 2 to 18. Up to Year 9 (Grade8), they follow the English National Curriculum, enhanced to meet the needs of our international student body. In Years 10 and 11(Grades 9 and 10) they follow the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE), a two-year course culminating in externally assessed examinations. In Years 12 and 13 (Grades 11 and 12) all our students enter either the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP) or the International Baccalaureate Career-related Programme (IBCP). Based on individual needs and plans, some students will complete IB subject certificates and/or internally assessed.

ACADEMIC PROGRAMMES

IGCSE - Years 10 and 11 (Grades 9 and 10)

Students take up to 11 individual examination subjects in the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) course. Many of our students also study an accelerated mathematics programme. All students may choose Double or Triple Award Science at IGCSE. While both options include physics, chemistry and biology, Triple Award Science is more rigorous.

Grades are on a scale of A* to G for Cambridge subjects and 9 to 1 for Edexcel subjects, with a letter grade of U indicating a failure to meet minimum standards.

IB Diploma Programme/IB Career-related Programme - Years 12 and 13 (Grades 11 and 12)

DCSZ students start the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP)/the International Baccalaureate Career-related Programme (IBCP) in Year 12 (Grade 11) in preparation for university.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

At DCSZ, the Co-Curricular Activity (CCA) programme covers many of the activities that take place beyond the taught curriculum. We consider this to be an integral part of the students' journey through their schooling, as it affords an opportunity for students to experience and deepen their interests and abilities in a wide range of areas. Our CCA programme offers numerous activities in the areas of Academia, The Arts, and Sport. Last year, the College introduced an Enrichment focus to the programme, consisting of a range of Societies that reflect students' key learning areas including a Science Society, a Mathematics Society, a Law Society, and an Entrepreneurial Society.

GRADING

We do not rank our students or calculate grade point averages. For the duration of course work, student progress is continuously assessed. DCSZ has changed our data reporting to semesterly, from triannually/termly, and this is is further noted on any academic transcripts produced for our students. Additionally, we use pre-established, standards-based performance levels for all year groups. Years 10 and 12 conclude with internally assessed exams while Years 11 and 13 conclude with externally assessed examinations.

DISCIPLINE POLICY

DCSZ reports all out-of-school suspensions and exclusions that occur as a result of disciplinary incidents that raise significant concerns about a student's academic integrity or has a significant impact on the wellbeing of the student or others within the community.


