OUR SCHOOL

Dulwich College (Singapore) opened in 2014 and educates children from age 2 to 18. Our school serves 2967 students from over 50 different countries. There are over 1375 students in our Senior School, Years 7-13, with 160 in the graduating Class of 2025. The primary teaching language of DCSG is English. Up to age 5, students follow the Early Years Foundation Stage, and from Years 1 to 8, they follow the National Curriculum of England and Wales, which is enhanced to meet the needs of our international student body. In Years 9-11 DCSG offers a 3-year IGCSE/GCSE programme. The extended length of the programme allows us to provide opportunities for subject-based enrichment, to teach beyond the curriculum and to explore deeper and broader learning. This enhanced IGCSE programme prepares students for the rigours of the 2-year International Baccalaureate Programme (IBDP), or IB Courses or the IB Careers Programme (IBCP), in Years 12 and 13.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Our College offers over 100 different activities such as Model United Nations, Student Council, Sustainability Matters and the International Award in addition to the drama, arts and sports programmes. Service programmes support a host of local projects, ranging from working with the elderly to the delivery of food parcels for those in need. Our Performing Arts programme performs internationally and has connections with The Royal Shakespeare Company, Vienna Boys Choir, Manchester College of Music and LAMDA. For sport, students compete in a wide variety of sports locally and internationally with other international schools within both Singapore via the ACSIS sports league and in Asia. DCSG offers a dedicated 'IGNITE' pathway for identified highly talented students in the Performing Arts, Creative Arts, and Sport. Furthermore, students are given the opportunity to take part in the International Award, modelled on the Duke of Edinburgh Award, bronze, silver and gold standards.

GRADING

We do not rank our students or calculate grade point averages. For the duration of course work, student progress is internally assessed using pre-established, standards-based performance levels. Year 11 IGCSE courses and Year 13 IB conclude with externally assessed examinations.

ACADEMIC PROGRAMMES

IGCSE - Years 10 and 11 (Grades 9 and 10)

In Years 9-11 DCSG offers a 3-year IGCSE/GCSE programme. The extended length of the programme allows us to provide opportunities for subject-based enrichment, to teach beyond the curriculum and to explore deeper and broader learning. It encourages greater conceptual understanding, more in-depth knowledge and more sophisticated skills. In addition, all students study Global Skills, a taught course that lays a solid foundation of critical thinking, bring together elements of philosophy, current affairs, research methodologies and public speaking. Students take up to 11 externally assessed examination subjects.

IB Programme - Years 12 and 13 (Grades 11 and 12)

All DCSG students follow the IB Diploma (IBDP) or IB Courses or the IB Careers Programme (IBCP), both of which also result in an accredited High School Diploma.

Our fourth graduating Class of 2024 with 125 students matriculated to a diverse distribution of destinations 47.2% UK, US and Canada 14.6%, Australia: 14.6%, Asia: 6.5%, Europe: 5.7% and the remaining 11.4% will embark on their National Service in Singapore.
