

OUR SCHOOL

We are a Beijing-based British international school that follows the internationally recognised IGCSE curriculum followed by the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme. Since we opened our doors in 2005, Dulwich College Beijing has been named British International School of the Year (2011) by the UK Independent Schools Awards. In 2017, the College also won a British International School Award for Teaching Initiative and a Corporate Social Responsibility Award. In 2019, DCB SE21 won the International School Award for Creativity in Learning. Our graduating classes have achieved IB results and university placements that place the school among the world's best.

SCHOOL CALENDAR

Due to school closures and local COVID-19 restrictions, the Class of 2023 engaged in e-learning or hybrid learning during the following dates: Early February to June 2020, August 2020-October 2020, January 2021, August 2021, February 2022, April to June and November to December 2022. Due to local restrictions, the majority of after-school extracurricular activities and interschool athletic competitions were curtailed. Opportunities to pursue internships, volunteer work, and other activities outside of school were much more limited than in previous years.

Instances in which a student was or continues to be adversely affected by the changes to their learning, including lack of access to standardized testing or major disruptions to teaching and learning, will be directly addressed in their application.

ACADEMIC PROGRAMMES

Overview

Our students come from over 30 countries and range in age from 3 to 18. Up to Year 9 (Grade 8), we follow the English National Curriculum, enhanced to meet the needs of our international student body. In Years 10 and 11 (Grades 9 and 10), we follow the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE), a two-year course culminating in externally assessed examinations.

In Years 12 and 13 (Grades 11 and 12), all students enter the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP).

IGCSE - Years 10 and 11 (Grades 9 and 10)

Students take up to 11 individual examination subjects in the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) course. The majority of our students also study an accelerated mathematics programme and enhanced Chinese instruction. While both Double Award and Triple Award Science include physics, chemistry and biology, Triple Award Science is more rigorous. Grades are on a scale of A* to G and 9-1, with a letter grade of U indicating a failure to meet minimum standards. Students also have the option of taking one of two specially designed internally assessed courses. Our STEM course delivers 21st century design and technology competencies through an interdisciplinary curriculum. Students also have the option of taking a humanities-based liberal arts course that focuses on a wide range of disciplines from philosophy to film studies to the classics.

IB Diploma Programme - Years 12 and 13 (Grades 11 and 12)

All DCB students start the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP) in Year 12 (Grade 11) in preparation for university. The Class of 2023 graduated 86 students, with 83 IB diploma candidates. 82 were awarded the IB diploma.

It is our school's practice to only give out a few academic achievement awards every year, so the students who do earn these awards have distinguished themselves in their individual subjects. Senior school students are only eligible to earn academic awards during Years 7-12.

GRADING

We do not rank our students or calculate grade point averages. For the duration of course work, student progress is continuously assessed. DCB reports triannually using pre-established, standards-based performance levels. Years 10 and 12 conclude with internally assessed exams while Years 11 and 13 conclude with externally assessed examinations.

DISCIPLINE POLICY

DCB reports all out-of-school suspensions and exclusions that occur as a result of disciplinary incidents that raise significant concerns about a student's academic integrity or has a significant impact on the wellbeing of the student or others within the community.

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
2023 IB RESULTS
