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

Our School

Dulwich College Suzhou (DCSZ) is a British independent international school serving 997 expatriate English-speaking students, of whom 38 are in the Class of 2019.

Our students come from over 40 countries and range in age from 2 to 18. Up to Year 9 (Grade 8) they follow the English National Curriculum, enhanced to meet the needs of our international student body. In Years 10 and 11 (Grades 9 and 10) they follow the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE), a two-year course culminating in externally assessed examinations. In Years 12 and 13 (Grades 11 and 12) all our students enter the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP). Based on individual needs and plans, some students will complete IB subject certificates and/or internally assessed exams to earn a High School Diploma (HSDP).

The Dulwich Network

DCSZ is one of ten international schools in Asia that operate in partnership with Dulwich College in London under the World Charter and together they make up Dulwich College International (DCI). Dulwich College in London inspects DCSZ and each Dulwich international school annually.

School Calendar

The school year is 181 days, running from mid-August to mid-June. It is divided into three terms.

Grading

We do not rank our students or calculate grade point averages. For the duration of course work, student progress is continuously assessed. DCSZ reports triannually using pre-established, standards-based performance levels. Years 10 and 12 conclude with internally assessed exams while Years 11 and 13 conclude with externally assessed examinations.

Discipline Policy

DCSZ reports all out-of-school suspensions, exclusions and withdrawals that arise as a result of a disciplinary incident that raises significant concerns about academic integrity or wellbeing of self or others.

Co-curricular Activities

Our College offers over 100 different activities in addition to drama, arts and sports programmes, such as Model United Nations, Student Council, Green Garderners and the Duke of Edinburgh International Award. Students compete in sports at multiple levels against other international schools in Asia.

Academic Programmes

IGCSE - Years 10 and 11 (Grades 9 and 10)

Students take up to 10 individual examination subjects in the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) course. The majority of our students also study an accelerated mathematics programme.

All students may choose Double or Triple Award Science at IGCSE. While both options include physics, chemistry and biology, Triple Award Science is more rigorous.

Grades are on a scale of A^* to G, with a letter grade of U indicating a failure to meet minimum standards.

IB Diploma Programme - Years 12 and 13 (Grades 11 and 12)

All DCSZ students start the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP) in Year 12 (Grade 11) in preparation for university.

University Matriculations 2015 - 2018

We believe in helping students choose prospective colleges and universities based on "fit". For this reason, students are limited to 10 applications worldwide each academic year.
