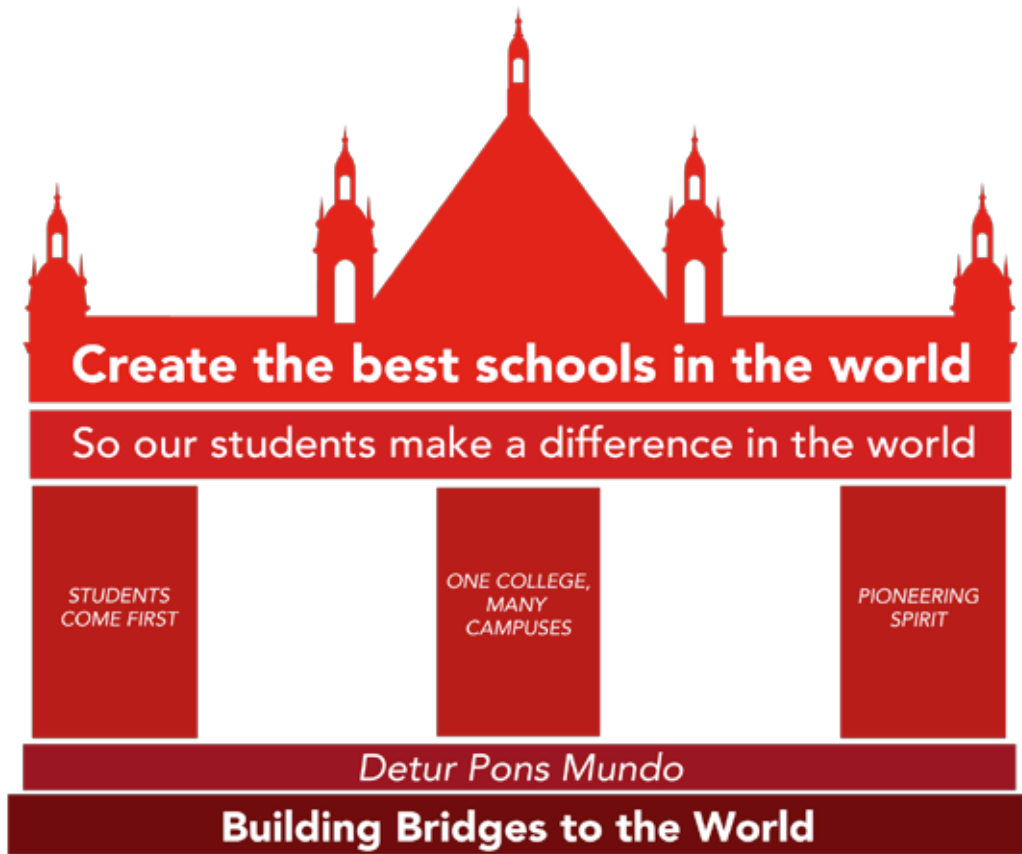


The Shakespeare Festival
