The Dulwich Network

Founded by an Elizabethan actor, Edward Alleyn in South London as a boys' school in 1619, Dulwich College is one of the UK's oldest independent schools. Dulwich College International was established to bring the Dulwich educational philosophy to students around the world and is now the fastest growing UK independent school network overseas. All of our schools operate in partnership with our founding school under the World Charter. Dulwich College inspects each Dulwich international school annually.

The Dulwich College International network of schools currently provides for over 9,000 students in eight cities in four countries in Asia with Colleges in Beijing, Seoul, Shanghai, Singapore, Suzhou and Yangon as well as two International High Schools in Suzhou and Zhuhai, and sister schools in Shanghai, Beijing, and Xi'an.


Our School

Dulwich College Shanghai Puxi educates children from ages 2 to 18 and currently serves 350 students from ages 2 to 15. Throughout the Dulwich Kindergarten, students follow the Early Years Foundation Stage and the College offers a rich, dual language approach to learning in both English and Mandarin. From age 7, the primary teaching language becomes English in the Junior School with daily, streamed Mandarin lessons to support language development. Throughout the Junior School, students follow the National Curriculum of England and Wales, which is enhanced to meet the needs of our international student body. In Year 9 students embark on a three-year set of IGCSE (International General Certificate of Secondary Education) courses, a rigorous course that requires students to take a broad range of subjects covering maths and sciences, English and foreign languages, and the humanities. It culminates in exams at the end of Year 11, and prepares students well for the two-year International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP) starting in Year 12. Our current Year 9 students will be the first to participate in the two-year IB Diploma programme. They will graduate in 2022 as our first cohort for Dulwich College Shanghai Puxi.

The school year is 181 days, running from mid-August to mid-June. It is divided into three terms.

Co-curricular Activities

Students at Dulwich College Shanghai Puxi have abundant opportunities to explore their creativity, pursue their interests and satisfy their intellectual curiosity outside the classroom. Starting from the Reception class (age 4) through to Senior School, all students are encouraged to take advantage of the many co-curricular activities available at the College, to learn and develop new skills or devote time to an interest. From high performance swimming in our Olympic Pool, to fencing, debating or serving the community, there are many things on offer to spark the individual child.

Academic Programmes

Senior School

Students take 8 individual examination subjects in the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) course. They study physics, chemistry and biology as separate subjects and are examined in each discipline.

Grades are on a scale of A* to G, with a letter grade of U indicating a failure to meet minimum standards.

IB Diploma Programme - Years 12 and 13 (Grades 11 and 12)

All Dulwich College Shanghai Puxi students will start the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP) in Year 12 (Grade 11) in preparation for university. Our current Year 9 students, the graduating class of 2022, will be the first cohort to embark on the IB Diploma programme.
