



SCHOOL PROFILE 2019 / 2020

The Dulwich Network

Founded by an Elizabethan actor, Edward Alleyn in South London as a boys' school in 1619, Dulwich College is one of the UK's oldest independent schools. Dulwich College International was established to bring the Dulwich educational philosophy to students around the world and is now the fastest growing UK independent school network overseas. All of our schools operate in partnership with Dulwich College under the World Charter. Dulwich College inspects each Dulwich international school annually.

The Dulwich College International network of schools currently provides for over 9,000 students in eight cities in four countries in Asia with Colleges in Beijing, Seoul, Shanghai Singapore, Suzhou and Yangon as well as two International High Schools in Suzhou and Zhuhai, and sister schools in Shanghai, Beijing, and Xi'an.

Our School

Dulwich College Yangon Pun Hlaing joined the Dulwich College International (DCI) family of schools in 2015, and our Star City campus opened in 2017. The Pun Hlaing and Star City campuses currently cater for students from Toddler to Year 10, spread over an Early Years, Junior School and Senior School. We offer boarding to students from Year 7, at our Star City Campus. There is also a scholarship programme available for students looking to join Years 7 to 10, on both campuses. The campuses will both continue to grow each year, until Year 11. Our academically selective schools provide a well-rounded education founded on academic rigour complemented by rich extra-curricular programmes. Our international schools follow a culturally and academically enhanced English National Curriculum. This lead to the award of International General Certificates of Secondary Education (IGCSEs) following the sitting of final examinations at the end of Year 11. In the final two years we intend, subject to the necessary approvals, to offer students in Years 12 and 13 the IB (International Baccalaureate) Diploma programme, at the Star City Campus. The programme is internationally recognized and provides access to top-class universities. It provides many opportunities for collaboration and student-led, in-depth research into areas of interest.

School Calendar

The school year is 181 days, running from mid-August to mid-June. It is divided into three terms.

Grading

We do not rank our students or calculate grade point averages. Students are given plentiful formative feedback at all stages of the school. In the Senior School, formal examinations do take place in the summer term. IGCSE and IB courses conclude with externally assessed examinations.

Discipline Policy

DCB reports all out-of-school suspensions, exclusions and withdrawals that arise as a result of a disciplinary incident that raises significant concerns about academic integrity or wellbeing of self or others.

Co-curricular Activities

The College offers an extensive range of clubs and extra-curricular activities. These are offered on an optional basis as part of the tuition fees. In addition, a number of out-sourced providers offer activities such as ballet and martial arts at the College to complement the expertise of the staff. There is an additional charge for these activities.

For the 2019-2020 academic year, activities available across our two campuses include rugby, kendo, taekwondo, basketball, creative writing, orchestra, cooking, chess, choir and creative art. Activities are updated each term and cater for a wide range of talents and interests.

We want our students to challenge themselves and venture beyond their comfort zones and give them opportunities to participate in trips to domestic and international destinations. This allows our students to experience a wide range of cultures in a learning environment that the classroom cannot always provide.
