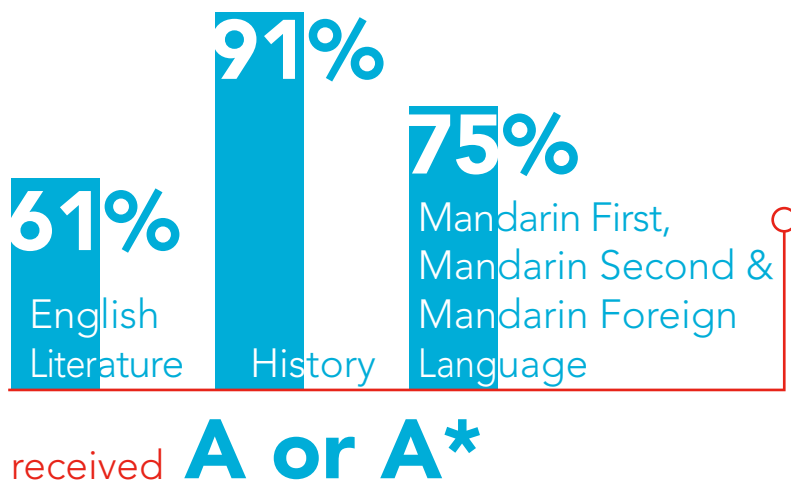


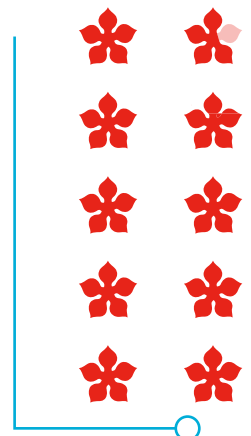

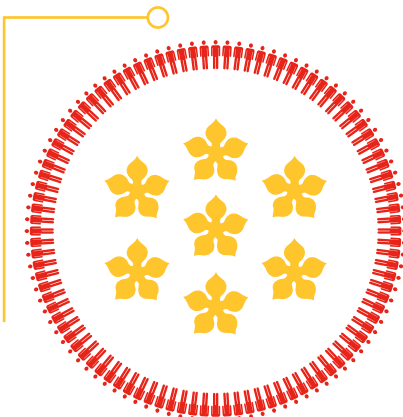

INTERNATIONAL GENERAL CERTIFICATE OF SECONDARY EDUCATION (IGCSE) PROGRAMME

The GCSE is a UK-based programme considered to be world-class preparation for further education, offering breadth and depth of study and skill development. The “I” in IGCSE refers to the international adaptation of the curriculum. At DCB, some of our courses at this level follow the GCSE curriculum because we believe that these courses are a better fit for our students. There is no difference in academic standards between IGCSE and GCSE.

The programme is completed over two years and evaluated through internal (coursework) and external (examinations) assessment at the end of the course. During these years, students develop a range of essential skills which encourage greater independence and critical thinking, all with the support of dynamic Senior School staff. Many varied opportunities beyond the curriculum, including sports, performing arts, creative arts, service and debating, encourage students to achieve life balance and gain leadership experience.

During the student application process, subject choices are discussed in depth with the Head of Key Stage. The full Curriculum Guide can be provided upon request.
