Dear Parents,

Please find the Dulwich College Shanghai Puxi Co-Curricular Activity (CCA) Programme for Term 1 of the 2020-2021 Academic Year. Please read the information below carefully and complete your child's selections using Schools Buddy. Please note that lunch time activities will be arranged separately by staff and pupils will have chance to take part in lunch time activities if they so choose.

Co-Curricular Activity (CCA) Programme 2020 Term 1

Junior School pupils in Years 3 to 6 have the option to take part in a number of after school Co-Curricular Activities from 3.30-4.40pm. Some activities will run beyond 4.40pm until 5.00pm. Please take note when completing your child's sign up on Schools Buddy. Pupils will meet in the restaurant after school at 3.30pm for snacks and registration.

Dates

After school CCAs will run for 10 weeks from Monday 14th September until Friday 27th November. (There will be no CCA on Thursday 1st October and Friday 2nd October due to the national holiday. There will be no make up week.)

Collecting Pupils

This year there will be a second school bus run on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday at 4.40pm. Pupils can take the second bus home from College after CCAs or parents can collect children after CCAs. On Monday and Friday there will not be a second bus run and pupils MUST be collected by parents from College at 4.40pm or 5.00pm. Please note that all children must have left the College premises by 5.15pm.

In most cases all students will be confirmed for their chosen activity.

By signing your child up for externally provided CCAs, in the event of non-payment, you are agreeing to allow the College to share your email address to the external providers so that they can contact you. TYPES OF ACTIVITY- YEAR 3, YEAR 4, YEAR 5 AND YEAR 6

Earthquakes Football (Development)

Year 3 -Year 6

Firday, 3:30 - 5:00

Join the poular Earthquakes football programme as they develop their programme at Dulwich College Shanghai Puxi. Earthquakes offer one day of development training on Friday. Pupils will be given an Earthquakes football kit and will be coached by highly qualified football coaches.

Fencing Year 3 -Year 6 Tuesday, 3:30 - 4:40

A fantastic opportunity for our pupils to enjoy the Olympic sport of fencing. Dulwich College Shanghai Puxi has a strong tradition of fencing and after a popular first year of our fencing programme, we hope to expand on this and develop it further. Your children will have the chance to receive training from an expert fencing coach and will learn the basics of the sport at an early age.



Senior and Junior Orchestra Year 3 -Year 6

Monday, 3:30 - 4:40

All students who take instrumental lessons inside or outside of school regularly are welcome to join the Junior or Senior Orchestra. There is no audition for Junior orchestra, however students should be able to play at approximately Grade 2/3 ABRSM level. An audition is required for students to join the Senior orchestra. Please ask Mr Haslett for more details. If selected this is a compulsory session that pupils will be required to attend.



Mad Science Year 3 -Year 6 Monday, 3:30 - 4:40

Your child will be exposed to a vast array of experiments to generate scientific curiosity and creativity. Expect your child to have lots of fun and excitement developing their love for Science and the world around them.



Jazz Dance/Hip hop Year 3 -Year 6 Monday, 3:30 - 4:40

Calling all budding dancers to join Spotlight's Hip Hop CCA! Hip hop dancing is very dynamic and refers to dance styles developed from several cultures including jazz rock, tap, and American and Latino cultures. In this class students will dance to their favourite tracks, learn fun routines focusing on Hip Hop techniques such as popping and locking, as well as break dancing.

Drumming Year 3 -Year 6 Thursday, 3:30 - 4:40

All students who love to play drums are welcome to attend the Drumming CCA. Students will develop their rhythmic skills and get to perform at dfferent events across the year. This activity is led by ForTune Music Studio.



Junior Swim Squad Year 3 -Year 6

Tuesday and Thurday, 3:30 - 4:40

The swimming squad will be selected from time trials. If your child is selected there will be a number of days that your child can choose to train. There is a commitment of 2 sessions per week. During the year The College will enter a number of swimming galas against other International schools in Shanghai.



Football Year 3 -Year 6 Tuesday, 3:30 - 4:40

Train with Mr King and Mr Kopfli to get ready for the Mustangs. In this activity, you will train hard and learn new skills to help develop your ability in football. Looking at different areas of play and game tactics, we look ahead to the Mustangs football begin to charge!



ABRSM Scales (Violin) Year 3 -Year 6 Tuesday, 3:30 - 4:40

This activity will help your child prepare for the ABRSM violin examinations. It focuses on the skills required to perform basic scalic patterns, articulation, tone production, sight reading and listening skills as outlined by the ABRSM board requirments.

ABRSM Scale (Cello) Year 3 -Year 6 Tuesday, 3:30 - 4:40

This activity will help your child prepare for the ABRSM Cello examinations. It focuses on the skills required to perform basic scalic patterns, articulation, tone production, sight reading and listening skills as outlined by the ABRSM board requirments.



Floorball Year 3 -Year 6

Thursday, 3:30 - 4:40

An extremely popular sport at Dulwich College Shanghai Puxi. Floorball is a form of hockey played with plastic sticks, it is fast, furious and extremely exciting. A great sport that all of the pupils thoroughly enjoy.

Aviation Year 3 -Year 6 Monday, 3:30 - 4:40

Your child will get chance to experience the aircraft simulator and develop their knowledge of aviation.



Weiqi Club Year 4 -Year 6

Wednesday, 3:30 - 4:40

An abstract strategy board game, in which the aim is to surround more territory than the opponent. The game was invented in China more than 2,500 years ago and is believed to be the oldest board game continuously played to the present day.



Junior Choir Year 3 -Year 6

Wednesday, 3:30 - 4:40

Singing at Dulwich College Shanghai Puxi is a strength of the College. Junior choir will take place on Wednesdays and all students are welcome to attend!




Music Theory ABRSM Year 3 -Year 6

Thursday, 3:30 - 4:40

The objective of this course is to help students better prepare ABRSM Music Theory exam. This course is helpful to their sight-reading, listening, rhythm, creativity in basic composing and to taking their musical skills to higher level.

Group Singing Year 3 -Year 6

Tuesday, 3:30 - 4:40

This is an opportunity for your child to participate in group singing lessons with our external providers ForTune Music Studio.

Children will develop their singing talents and improve their voice control and performing confidence, learning how to perform with style! They will have the chance to sing individually or as part of a group and learn to develop their stage presence.



Kayaking Year 5 -Year 6 Friday, 3:30 - 4:40

Year 5 pupils have the chance to take part in the fun sport of kayaking. Pupils can enjoy learning the basic skills of kayaking and have fun in the pool in the Dulwich College Shanghai Puxi house coloured kayaks.



Junior School Basketball Club Year 3 -Year 6

Tuesday, 3:30 - 4:40

They will develop their basketball knowledge, understanding and skills as they play for fun against their friends. Monday, 3:30 - 4:40



ABRSM Music Aural Year 3 -Year 6 Monday, 3:30 - 4:40

The aural listening test is one of the most important parts of the ABRSM examinations. Children need to pass both the aural test and instrument to get the ABRSM certificate. This CCA will help children understand how the ABRSM aural exams works, develop their aural skills to pass the exam with confidence. Children will also learn to develop their 'musical ear', learn how to play in tune, develop their musical memory and spot any mistakes while playing their instruments – all while having fun!

ABRSM Accompaniment Year 3 - Year 6

Friday, 3:30 - 4:40

The ABRSM Accompaniment class is an ensemble class for all instruments students except piano. Through this class, students can learn how to play along with other instruments, how to express their feelings in playing. This class also serves as a preparation course for students taking the graded ABRSM practical examinations.



Badminton Year 3 -Year 6

Friday, 3:30 - 4:40

A very popular sport at Dulwich College Shanghai Puxi and an opportunity for our junior school students to play recreational badminton, learn skills and have lots of fun competing against each other. They may even get to play against some of the teachers!
