Dear Parents,

Please find the Dulwich College Shanghai Puxi Co-Curricular Activity (CCA) Programme for Term 1 of the 2020-2021 Academic Year. Please read the information below carefully and complete your child's selections using Schools Buddy. Please note that lunch time activities will be arranged separately by staff and pupils will have chance to take part in lunch time activities if they so choose.

Co-Curricular Activity (CCA) Programme 2020 Term 1

Senior School pupils in Years 7 to 11 have the option to take part in a number of after school Co-Curricular Activities from 3.30-4.40pm. Some activities will run beyond 4.40pm until 5.00pm. Please take note when completing your child's sign up on Schools Buddy. Pupils will meet in the restaurant after school at 3.30pm for snacks and registration.

Dates

After school CCAs will run for 10 weeks from Monday 14th September until Friday 27th November. (There will be no CCA on Thursday 1st October and Friday 2nd October due to the national holiday and the week 21st-25th September due to residential.)

Collecting Pupils

This year there will be a second school bus run on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday at 4.40pm. Pupils can take the second bus home from College after CCAs or parents can collect children after CCAs. On Monday and Friday there will not be a second bus run and pupils MUST be collected by parents from College at 4.40pm or 5.00pm. Please note that all children must have left the College premises by 5.15pm.

Please log in to your Schools Buddy account, complete the sign up and click save and confirm to complete the selections. Sign ups MUST be complete by Monday 7th September. After this date details will be collated and I will confirm all selections. You will receive an email showing the activities that your child has been selected for. In most cases all students will be confirmed for their chosen activity.

Externally Provided Activities and Payments

If your child is taking part in an externally provided activity then you should make payment to the external provider within the first two weeks of CCAs beginning. By signing your child up for externally provided CCAs, in the event of non-payment, you are agreeing to allow the College to share your email address to the external providers so that they can contact you. TYPES OF ACTIVITY- YEAR 7 - YEAR 11

Senior and Junior Orchestra Year 7 -Year 11 Monday, 3:30 - 5:00

All students who take instrumental lessons inside or outside of school regularly are welcome to join the Junior or Senior Orchestra. There is no audition for Junior orchestra, however students should be able to play at approximately Grade 2/3 ABRSM level. An audition is required for students to join the Senior orchestra. Please ask Mr Haslett for more details. If selected this is a compulsory session that pupils will be required to attend.



Hip hop Dance Year 7 -Year 11 Tuesday, 3:30 - 4:40

Calling all budding dancers to join Spotlight's Hip Hop CCA! Hip hop dancing is very dynamic and refers to dance styles developed from several cultures including jazz rock, tap, and American and Latino cultures. In this class students will dance to their favourite tracks, learn fun routines focusing on Hip Hop techniques such as popping and locking, as well as break dancing.



Senior Swim Squad Year 7 - Year 11

Tuesday & Thursday, 3:30 - 4:40

The swimming squad will be selected from time trials. If your child is selected there will be a number of days that your child can choose to train. There is a commitment of 2 sessions per week. During the year The College will enter a number of swimming galas against other International schools in Shanghai.



Mustangs football Year 7 -Year 11 Thursday, 3:30 - 4:40

The senior boys football squad will train every Thursday in preparation for CISSA fixtures on Thursday in Term 1. The senior boys football squad is by selection only.



Mustangs Netball Year 7 - Year 11

Thursday, 3:30 - 4:40

Netball is a very popular sport at Dulwich College Shanghai Puxi. Senior girls netball practice is a selected activity to enable training for upcoming fixtures for the U19, U15 and U13 teams.



Leadership Year 7 -Year 11 Monday, 3:30 - 4:40

This CCA is for Senior School students who hold a leadership position in the school. Each Monday the student leadership team will meet to discuss plans for the year and responsibilities of each leader. This CCA is also reserved for students who need time to meet other stakeholders or simply time to plan an event, write a proposal or a news article.



ABRSM Scale Violin Year 7 -Year 11 Tuesday, 3:30 - 4:40

This activity will help your child prepare for the ABRSM violin examinations. It focuses on the skills required to perform basic scalic patterns, articulation, tone production, sight reading and listening skills as outlined by the ABRSM board requirments.

ABRSM Scale (Cello) Year 7 -Year 11 Tuesday, 3:30 - 4:40



Advanced Robotics Year 10 -Year 11

Wednesday, 3:30 - 4:40

We will use a powerful single board computer (SBC) and attach sensors so that it can capture images and sounds from the surrounding environment. We will then learn to use artificial intelligence, image classification and speech recognition to process the information. Strong working knowledge of Python (IGCSE level or above) is required.



Forte Choir Year 7 - Year 11

Wednesday, 3:30 - 4:40

The choir at Dulwich College Shanghai Puxi is a strength of The College. Senior school choir practice will take place on Wednesdays. We endeavor to ensure that our choir remains an important part of the growing College.



Weiqi Club Year 7 -Year 11

Wednesday, 3:30 - 4:40

An abstract strategy board game, in which the aim is to surround more territory than the opponent. The game was invented in China more than 2,500 years ago and is believed to be the Idest board game continuously played to the present day.




Music Theory ABRSM Year 7 - Year 11

Thursday, 3:30 - 4:40

This course is aimed at students who have reached the level of musical instruments equivalent to the level of ABRSM 3 or above and for students who are beginners wishing to take the ABRSM exams.

The objective of this course is to help students better prepare ABRSM Music Theory exam. This course is helpful to their sight-reading, listening, rhythm, creativity in basic composing and to taking their musical skills to higher level.



Kayaking Year 7 -Year 9

Friday, 3:30 - 4:40

Year 7-9 pupils have the chance to take part in the fun sport of kayaking. Pupils can enjoy learning the basic skills of kayaking and have fun in the pool in the Dulwich College Shanghai Puxi House coloured kayaks.



Senior School Basketball Club Year 7 -Year 11 Friday, 3:30 - 4:40

A very popular sport at Dulwich College Shanghai Puxi and an opportunity for our senior school students to play recreational badminton, learn skills and have lots of fun competing against each other. They may even get to play against some of the teachers!



LAMDA – Acting Year 7-Year 11 Monday, 3:30 - 4:40

Join Spotlight's Acting CCA to explore core acting skills and performance techniques in a fun, creative environment taught by industry professionals. Our Senior Acting CCA will cover improvisation to build confidence and creativity in ideas, movement to explore storytelling through physicality, spoken voice work: focusing on breath control, accents, tone and modulation to create engaging characters. Using the LAMDA Examination syllabus, students will delve into a range of contemporary and classical play texts to produce imaginative, original performances, as well as touching upon directorial projects. Students will have the opportunity to enter for their LAMDA Acting Examinations in December 2020.



LAMDA - Public Speaking Year 7-Year 11

Monday, 3:30 - 4:40

The Spotlight Public Speaking CCA provides a wonderful foundation for students to develop self-confidence in a fun, creative and practical environment. Using a series of drama-based techniques students will cover a wide range of communication skills to enhance confidence and conviction when speaking in public.


Students will explore debate techniques, body language, speech writing and interview tips, while also developing their improvisational skill-set. Students will gain a foundational understanding of voice theory and vocal delivery - such as breath control, vocal projection and clarity of speech to create dynamic, coloured vocal performances. Students will have the opportunity to enter for their LAMDA Speaking in Public Examinations in December 2020.



STEAM ART Year 7-Year 9 Tuesday, 3:30 - 4:40

STEM + Art = S.T.E.A.M


This program includes musical instrument production, interior design and product design. Students will create different hand crafts with various themes which are inspired by original story videos. After the CCA students can also scan the QR code to continue listening to the interesting stories and create at more at home!



ABRSM Music Aural Year 7-Year 11 Friday, 3:30 - 4:40

The aural listening test is one of the most important parts of the ABRSM examinations. Children need to pass both the aural test and instrument to get the ABRSM certificate. This CCA will help children understand how the ABRSM aural exams works, develop their aural skills to pass the exam with confidence. Children will also learn to develop their 'musical ear', learn how to play in tune, develop their musical memory and spot any mistakes while playing their instruments – all while having fun!

Sand Painting Year 7-Year 11

Wednesday, 3:30 - 4:40

Sand painting integrates painting, light effect to bring people a full range of visual enjoyment. Students will start from the basic drawing skills, such as how to spread and erase sand, draw the outline, mark shapes and more details with sand on the white glass. Students can be able to create their unique image formed with sand by applying painting skills.

Wednesday, 3:30 - 4:40


